Where you will go?



At Eastgate House, we have friendly people who are good at looking after children.



There are lots of reasons why you might come to see us. It is usually because someone is worried about you.

What is going to happen here?



You might come to Eastgate House with your parents or carer, or some other adults like a social worker or the police.



You will meet one of our helpers and a doctor. The doctor will talk and listen to you, and you can ask any questions you like.

How will the doctor look at you?



The doctor will also talk to the grownups that come with you.



The doctor will ask if they can look at your body all over.



The grownup that came with you will stay with you if you want them to and so will the doctor's helper.



The check-up will not hurt, but if you're not happy just tell the doctor.



You can say 'no' at any time.
