Adult Learning Disability Health (ALDH) Service

Our Service ensures that learning disability is 'everyone's business' and that people with a learning disability and their families have access to the services they need.

We are a multiprofessional team who support people who need help because of their learning disability. We hold weekly local meetings to ensure people get the right care and support.



Where are our teams based?

- Castlewood, Clevedon, North Somerset
- New Friends Hall, Stapleton, Bristol
- Church House, Kingswood, South Gloucestershire

How can we help?

Our teams help people with a learning disability through providing advice and guidance to other services. We provide training on how to work with people who have a learning disability and make reasonable adjustments. We also offer direct care and treatment where a specialist learning disability service is required.

Clinical support available from our multi-professional team includes:

- Learning disability nursing
- Psychiatry
- Positive behaviour support
- Mental health nursing
- Speech and language therapy
- Psychological therapies
- Physiotherapy
- Cancer screening practitioner
- Occupational therapy.

Who does our team see?

We accept referrals for people who:

- have a global learning disability.
- have a learning disability that stops them from being supported by mainstream health services, even with the provision of reasonable adjustments and advice.
- have a health need that requires a specialist learning disability service.

We don't see people who:

- have a brain injury that they developed after 18 years of age.
- have a mental health or physical impairment as their main need for support. For these people we will support other services to make reasonable adjustments.
- have specific learning difficulties, such as Dyslexia, ADHD, and Autism without a global Learning Disability.
- We are not commissioned to diagnose learning disabilities.

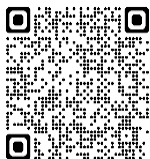
